If someone has a cardiac arrest, then this is what to do...

1. Call 999 and ask for the South West Ambulance Service. Tell them where you are.
2. They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
3. Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance service will tell you what to do.
