- 1. Call 999 and ask for the South West Ambulance Service. Tell them where you are.
- 2. They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
- 3. Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance service will tell you what to do.

The Southlands area has been chosen as a Liveable Neighbourhood, with investment available for the benefit of the local community. As a first step, planters have been used to trial a through traffic restriction since late November 2022, alongside a period of consultation on the effects of this, with a formal review after the local elections. Local **Elections**

On Thursday 4 May, we will be voting for our B&NES Ward Councillors for the next 4 years.

Changes in national legislation mean that for the first time voters will need to show photographic ID when they go to the polling station to vote in the local elections.

A passport, photocard driving licence, Blue Badge, Older Person's Bus Pass or a Disabled Person's Bus Pass (such as the Diamond Travelcard), are some of the documents that will be accepted as proof of identity before voters will be issued with a ballot paper at the polling station. Voters will also need to be on the electoral register. An accepted form of photo ID that is out of date can still be used if the name is the same as on the electoral register and the photo is recognisably you.

Voters who don't have an acceptable form of photo ID can apply for a free Voter Authority Certificate online or by completing a paper form. They can also apply for the certificate in person at the Guildhall in Bath.




