We have 4 defibrillators in the area Tesco | in Weston High Street Moravian Church | (on the wall in the car park) bottom of Lansdown Hill Methodist Church | top of Chelsea Road Oldfield School | (main reception) Kelston Road If someone has a cardiac arrest, then this is what to do...

- Call 999 and ask for the South West Ambulance Service. Tell them where you are.
- 2. They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
- 3. Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance service will tell you what to do.
